Israel's track record with water treatment and management has made it a global hub for related technologies. The country's lack of access to freshwater sources drove it to innovate. Its biggest accomplishment has been successfully scaling up desalination technology, to the degree that the predominantly desert country can today boast water independence. Israel is also a leader when it comes to wastewater processing, recycling 90% of its waste, repurposed for urban and agricultural irrigation. The local Water-Tech ecosystem also provides multiple solutions for water conservation, leading the way to a more sustainable future.


